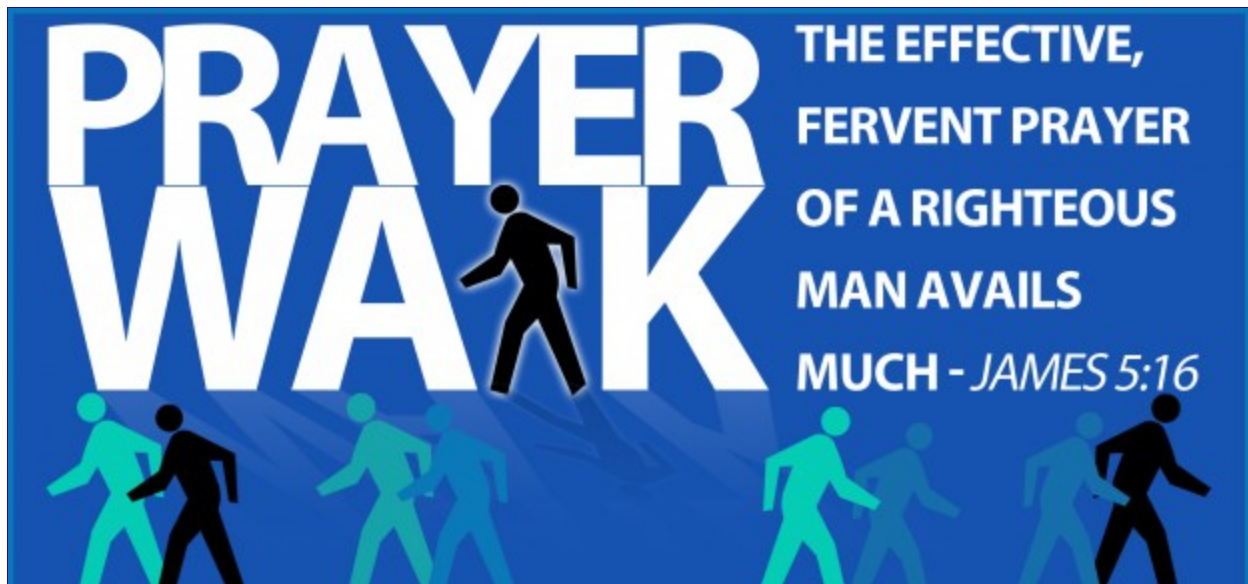
WOMEN'S MINISTRIES
